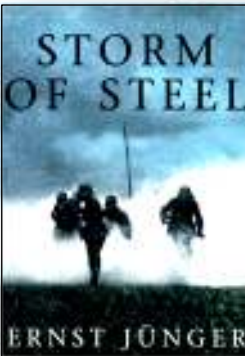

**STORM OF STEEL, by Ernst Jünger**

**About the Book:** *Storm of Steel* is the memoir of imperial Germany's Prussian officer Ernst Jünger's service on the Western Front during the First World War. In 1920, Jünger privately published an almost unedited version of the war diaries he had kept from August 1914 to August 1918, when his seventh battle injury caused retirement from the field. Known for graphic descriptions of trench warfare, the bestselling work has been revised many times. Based on the final 1961 version, a new English translation was made by Michael Hofmann in 2003, winning the 2004 Oxford-Weidenfeld Translation Prize. Each edition has carried the dedication "To the fallen."



Born in 1895, Jünger died in 1998 at the age of 102. He flatly refused to ever join the Nazi party.

Poplar Bluff Municipal Library offers free access to eBooks and audiobooks through the shared collection of **Missouri Libraries 2 Go** ([www.molib2go.org](http://www.molib2go.org)). Now you have access to even more titles through the program **OverDriveAdvantage**.

With OverDrive Advantage, the Poplar Bluff Municipal Library has purchased additional eBooks and audiobooks exclusively for holders of our library cards. Coupled with the shared collection, the Advantage program provides access to even more popular eBooks and audiobooks, with additional copies of popular materials.

To gain access to Advantage titles, simply sign in to the website with your library card. Once signed in, the Advantage titles become visible along with the shared collection. Browse for titles to borrow and enjoy on Windows and Mac computers, or on mobile devices like iPad, iPhone, Android, and Windows Phone. Users can read eBooks on the go with Kindle, Sony Reader, NOOK and more. Once the lending period ends, titles will automatically expire and return to the collection. There are no late fees or any action required.
