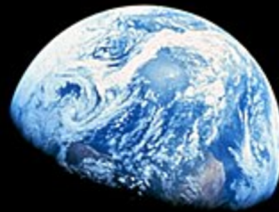


Calling All Artists:

The Poplar Bluff Library invites you to submit original artwork inspired by Apollo 8's infamous Earthrise photo. Your creations will be on display during our Beyond Earth exhibit. This exhibition coincides with the library's community read program, The Book in the Bluff. This year's selected title is *Rocket Men* by Robert Kurson. *Rocket Men* chronicles the historic 1968 Apollo 8 mission, the first time humans traveled to the far side of the Moon. The book highlights the intense pressure and ingenuity of NASA engineers and astronauts as they focused their collective efforts on answering President John F. Kennedy's call to land Americans on the Moon and return them safely to Earth by the end of the decade. Through courage, collaboration, and trust, Apollo 8 forever changed our understanding of what humanity could achieve together. This mission and the Earthrise photo are the inspiration behind this year's exhibit.

GUIDELINES / ELIGIBILITY

- Open to artists of all ages
- Artwork **MUST** be original works of art inspired by the Apollo 8 mission and the infamous *Earthrise* photo ; copyrighted works (licensed characters, photos of public art, etc.) can not be accepted
- Open to all forms and mediums
- 2D artwork may not exceed 16"x20" and should be wired to hang
- Artists interested in entering a 3D piece should contact the Outreach & Programming Manager at 573-686-8639 x 22.
- This is a family-friendly show; no works of an explicit nature can be accepted

Entry is open until 5 pm on Friday, March 13th. Completed artworks may be dropped off at the library's Main Branch during regular hours: Mondays through Thursdays from 9am-7pm, Fridays from 10am-5pm, Saturdays from 11am-3pm, and Sundays from 1pm-5pm. All submissions must be accompanied by a completed and signed entry form. Artwork can not be accepted if it does not meet guidelines/eligibility (at library staff's discretion) or without a completed entry form.
